APPEAL PROCESS OF MIDTERM EXAM GRADES

As the midterm season approaches, we wish you success. However, in case of a negative outcome, please be aware that every student has the opportunity to retake a failed midterm exam (it is considered a failure when the grade is lower than 5). The retake is limited to one attempt that you do not need to pay for, and it must be organized no later than 3 weeks after the original exam date. If multiple midterm exams are scheduled for a course, you can retake only one, which has the biggest weight. If you disagree with the lecturer's evaluation and/or the examination procedures, you have the right to submit an appeal to the academic department where you are enrolled within 5 working days from the announcement of the grade.

STUDIJŲ KAINOS KOMPENSAVIMAS

Students are compensated the price they have paid for their studies. Higher education institutions create and submit a list of students and graduates who are entitled to a tuition fee compensation to the State Studies Foundation in accordance with their established procedures. Applications to receive a tuition fee compensation in the year 2023 will be accepted in November and December 2023. Eligible candidates include students studying in non-state-funded places who have no academic debts, have fulfilled all the requirements of their study program, and have achieved excellent or typical academic performance.

HOUSING RENT COMPENSATION

After declaring your place of residence in the municipality where you are studying, you can receive compensation for rented housing up to 379 euros. (not valid for those living in a dormitory). Compensation is granted when the declared assets of a person without a family are up to EUR 13,671, and the net annual income is up to EUR 9.114.
